Zoe is a social elephant that does well on relationships and is highly motivated to please. Zoe works well on the reward of relationships and socialization. She is highly compliant in all medical aspects of her training. With the fact that she does base relationships high, Zoe has a tendency to exhibit nervousness when a stranger is first behind her, but once reassured by her trainers/herd dynamics, Zoe easily regains focus.

Dear Sir:

Cameron Park Zoo agrees with the strict enforcement of the Animal Welfare Act (AWA) and would encourage advancing training opportunities for inspectors and an increase in the number of APHIS inspectors. This ultimately means increasing the budget for APHIS in order for them to appropriately inspect and enforce the AWA.

Cameron Park Zoo is supportive of exceptional care for all the animals at our facility. We have supported and hosted, in conjunction with two other Texas AZA facilities, a USDA inspectors training course that focused on the care and management of elephants. Cameron Park Zoo is proud of the fact that we are an accredited member of the Association of Zoos & Aquariums. We were recently inspected by trained AZA accreditation inspectors and were found to be in compliance with the AZA Standards for Elephant Management and Care. Combined, our staff's experience with managing and caring for elephants spans over 75 years.

The petition by In Defense of Animals (IDA), seeking an interpretive rule and enforcement under the AWA to eliminate violations of the space and conditions regulations for elephants at zoos is fraught with inaccurate, misleading, and false statements. Their leading assumption, that small space is directly correlated with chronic foot and joint problems, is invalid and not supported by scientific evidence. The claim of arthritis and chronic foot and joint pain being absent from the wild is illogical. If there were scientific data on its absence from the wild, it would have been noted along with their other claims of fact. Research in this area may be warranted for future studies to improve existing standards already self imposed by AZA facilities .

There are many factors that affect chronic foot and joint pain as well as arthritis. For humans, the CDC lists factors such as age, gender, genetics, being overweight, joint injury, infection, and occupation, i.e. repetitive knee bending. The Harvard Medical School lists the same variables. If the medical community cannot pinpoint one factor for the cause of arthritis and foot and joint pain in humans, how can one factor be pinpointed in elephants.

Many facilities and management groups take different approaches to foot care practices. At Cameron Park Zoo, we use routine bathing and washing of the animals' feet. This will typically remove the major debris that has collected in the natural cracks of the footpad. The best foot care tool in our opinion is safe, close daily inspection of the foot, nails, and the pad. Occasionally, the use of Ferrier tools (hoof knives) will be used to

remove embedded rocks and hay in the callous foot pad. Typically, files or similar tools are used to maintain healthy nails or to correct cracks in the nail. This is likened to a major pedicure. If conducted properly, the animal's feet and nails are well managed.


Different types of substrates are available to our elephants. Our indoor holding stalls have heated concrete floors that have a rough broom finish. These floors are slightly sloped to allow proper drainage away from the animals feet. The exhibit yard is approximately one acre in size and consists of dirt and grass. During different times of the year, we add either dirt or sand as enrichment for the elephants to rub in and toss onto their backs. We believe that this combination allows us to reach a balance between natural substrate and a substrate that can be properly disinfected. It is our belief that elephants need to have a variety of substrates. That way the animal can actually choose the substrate they want to be on.

Elephants do need some form of physical exercise to keep them in good condition. This can take many forms from conducting typical behaviors to walking from point "A" to "B" and repeating that process as their keepers cue and reward them. We use both of these methods in addition to asking the animals to go through a variety of behaviors that allow us access to all parts of their body for close inspection. In the AZA standards, a formal exercise program is mandatory. That program is evaluated through the accreditation review and inspection process.

Facilities accredited by the Association of Zoos & Aquariums that hold elephants abide by the approved Standards for the Management and Care of Elephants. This is a comprehensive document that was developed by the group that is tasked with managing elephants in AZA facilities. This group consists of the most respected experts in elephant captive management in the United States. These standards go beyond the AWA requirements and continually change and improve each year.

AZA and its members work closely with USDA APHIS inspectors to ensure that the animals in AZA facilities receive the best possible care. They work together to assist in offering training for inspectors to provide additional insight into our industry. In a perfect world it would benefit the animals if additional funding and additional inspectors could be added to the USDA budget. It would be beneficial if animal welfare organizations could use their influence and resources to help support additional research, conservation projects in the wild, and assistance toward the improvement of the lives of the animal ambassadors that educate and inspire so many people.
