NARRATIVE

This routine inspection was conducted by Johnny Binder, Joe Grubic, and Dr. Kjos. An animal inventory is attached to this report.

CATEGORY I: Non-compliant item(s) previously identified that have been corrected.

Section 3.125 C Supplies of food and bedding shall be stored in facilities which adequately protect such supplies against deterioration, molding, or contamination by vermin. Feed and bedding were stored properly in the sac feed storage room.

Section 3.125 (a) Indoor housing facilities shall be maintained in good repair to protect the animals from injury. All repairs in porcupine and elephant areas have been completed.

CATEGORY III: Non-compliant item(s) identified this inspection

Section 3.125(b) Reliable and adequate electric power shall be available. In the rock hyrax holding area, there was a portable electrical heater in close proximity to water. Additional electrical outlets are necessary to prevent accidental electrical shock in this area. To be corrected by: February 4, 2000.

Section 3.129(a) The food shall be wholesome, palatable, and free from contamination. Food storage is currently in the restroom of the education building. Food preparation will be moved and stored more appropriately under the direction of the senior keeper. To be corrected by: February 4, 2000.
