- 11 JUN 00 Betty was delivered by George Carden around noon Saturday. She was kept in stall #3 for the evening after having access to the South yard during the afternoon. This morning she was introduced to Patience in stall #3 briefly, and then Onyx, Patience, and Betty were transferred to the south yard for the day. The three got along well all day. Patience and Betty were left in the yard together during Onyx's afternoon crush routine, then put in separate stalls (#2 and #3) with the door cracked afternoon. - J Glazier
- 21 JUN 00 Betty is coming into the crush well after a week of acclimation. The front door is closed, but the back door is left open while she eats and drinks. She has been given access to #2, the crush, and the South yard since last week at night. She is with Onyx during the day and gets along well with him. - M Carden
- 01 JUL 00 No longer attempting to get Betty in the crush due to concern of her drinking the dirty water in the yard. If blood is needed, we can trap her as needed. - D Luedde
- 02 JUL 00 Breeding activity was observed twice today, the first around 11:20 by a keeper, the second around 12:10 by a community service worker. There was possible penetration on the second attempt. Onyx and Betty were left together in the south yard for the evening due to Onyx refusing the crush. - D Luedde
- 03 JUL 00 No breeding activity was observed today. Onyx was separated in the afternoon to where Betty could get food, water, and bath in the south yard. - D Luedde
- 04 JUL 00 Breeding interest observed today at 10:40 and 12:10. No penetration was confirmed. Onyx refused to go into the crush morning and afternoon (from the South yard). Both 1.1 were hosed and given a small amount of water in the afternoon due to the heat.

- 05 JUL 00 Onyx attempted to breed Betty throughout the day. No penetration was observed, but they have been together around the clock for three days. Betty responds very well to Onyx and stands well for breeding. Betty appears to be very comfortable around Onyx, even during these breeding bouts. - M Carden
- 06 JUL 00 More breeding attempts today. Mounting was observed, but not penetration.

- 07 JUL 00 No breeding interest observed. He entered the crush twice today. - M Carden
- 30 JUL 00 George Carden came and picked Betty up. He got two tubes of blood from her.
