- 26.Jan complete during PM routine due to chain link catching on clevis. During the night Nisha was able to pass through door and have direct access to other elephants in bldg. This morning Nisha was in with Connie #1101 and Minyah #65. Patience #3320 was in adjoining stalls #1 and 2, Nisha probably went in with Patience as she can pass through the bars fairly easily. All elephants were calm, there was no indication of turmiol or stress. Door to #5 stall was opened partially and Nisha walked through it to her mother Moola (JB)

- 1.Feb Nisha escaped from cow bldg holding area during the night. Connie removed clevis from chain allowing Nisha to pass through bars. There were several of her stools present in Connie and Minyahk stalls. This AM Nisha was exhausted, intially not responsive to stimuli but soon demonstrated normal behaviors. No abnormalities or defects evident. Observed sleeping soundly around noon. (JB)

- 8.Feb Possible constipation
 - S) JG reports the lack of outside exposure may be causing mild constipation. Feces have been infrequent. She is not taking solid foods except as an exception of a pellet or piece of banana.
 - P) Requested blood for full workup and herpes testing. (SB)

- 13.Feb Took apple, still may have mild colic
 - S) During Connie tail and eye exam, we gave Nisha some apple I brought for rewards. She took two small pieces. She did have her legs crossed possibly indicating mild colic which JG thinks is constipation due to a lack of exercise (too cold for the past 2 weeks to put them outside often).
 - A) Constipation/ colic, herpes is always a concern
 - P) I suggested offering prunes and figs, possibly epsom salt water as a laxative. I also suggested a mineral oil enema or oral bolus (DL suggested with jello). I made a second request for blood for CBC, Chemistry, and herpes PCR. Bleeding is difficult for staff. (SB)

 - S) She refused prunes today. She came up to JG for an inspection. I could visualize two sets of molars. No edema or petechaie. Activity is BAR. She defected according to JG.

- 18 JUL 06 4022 delivered a 238 lb female calf, 6002, via posterior presentation at 1:35 a.m. At 1:45 a.m. the calf was standing unassisted. At 2:25 a.m. keepers dipped the umbilicus in Nolvasan solution. The calf passed Meconium at 2:27 and 2:34 (both with some effort). The calf searched for the nipple to suckle, but didn't have a strong suckling response initially, so at 4:04 a.m. 60 cc of colostrums was milked by keepers and fed to her using a catheter. The calf is unusually well coordinated with her trunk and is walking very well. The dam passed the placenta at 5:30 a.m. (weight 25 lbs). The calf first nursed at 5:33 a.m., was nursing well with assistance at 6:05 a.m., and was nursing on her own by 6:20 a.m. The calf intermittently walked, nursed and napped on her feet until early afternoon, at which time she began stretching and laying down occasionally to rest, along with standing. The calf has not been observed urinating or defecating as of 11:00 p.m., although observations were not continuous throughout the day. The calf was observed eating the dam's feces twice at 11:00 p.m. The calf is vocalizing more frequently this evening, eliciting an agitate response from the dam (i.e. hitting the chains, vocalizing and scuffing the floor). Measurements were taken as follows: Weight - 238 lbs; Height at top of back - 35"; Height at top of withers - 35"; Total length with trunk and tail relaxed - 41"; Length (withers to base of tail) - 32"; Length (point of shoulder to pin bone) - 18"; Abdominal girth - 50 ½"; Heart girth - 44 ½"; Neck girth - 28 ½"; Trunk length - 12"; Front foot and back foot circumferences - 20". - M Carden
- 19 JUL 06 Moola, 4022, and the calf, 6002, remained inside the cow barn in the back two stalls. The calf weighs 236 lbs. The calf is nursing well and sleeping standing up or lying down. Moola still has not slept since prior to the birth. The calf has not defecated since passing the Meconium shortly after birth. Urination has not been observed, but keeper observations have not been continuous. The calf's blood was taken at 4:30 p.m. for a CBC Chemistry and to bank. Connie, 1101, and Minyahk, 65, were brought into the cow barn with a stall separating them from the calf initially. After a short period, they were allowed in the adjoining stall without problems. - M Carden
- 20 JUL 06 Moola, 4022, and the calf, 6002, are being allowed in the cow barn, corral and south yard during the day, with Connie, 1101, and Minyahk, 65, without problems. The calf weighs 238 lbs today. The calf was observed urinating and defecating this afternoon. Moola and the calf are being locked in the back two stalls at night. Tonight is the last night of keeper observations. - M Carden
- 21 JUL 06 The calf, 6002, weighs 238 lbs today. Moola, 4002, Connie, Minyahk and the calf were placed in the exhibit yard for the day without incidence. The calf has been observed urinating and defecating normally. The calf has been drinking more water from the tub now. - M Carden
- 23 JUL 06 The calf, 6002, weighs 240 lbs today. All appears well.
- 24 JUL 06 Calf, 6002, weighs 240 lbs today. - D Luedde

- 28 JUL 06 Two saucer-sized pools of coagulated blood were observed in 4022 and 6002's stall this morning. To prevent sunburn on the calf, keepers began placing their hay under the shade trees and applying sunscreen to her face, hips, sides and feet as needed. -- M Carden
- 29 JUL 06 No blood was found in 4022 and 6022's stall today. The calf now weighs 248 lbs. The calf appears to be sunburned in several areas. Dr. Boylan was notified, and sunscreen will be applied as needed.

- 21 AUG 06 One month measurements for 6002: Body weight -- 284 lbs; height at top of back -- 38 inches; height at withers -- 36 inches; total length -- 39 inches; abdominal girth -- 56 inches; heart girth -- 52 inches; neck girth -- 29 inches; trunk length -- 14 inches; tail length -- 20 inches, front foot circumference -- 20 inches; back foot circumference -- 20 inches. -- J Glazier
- 22 AUG 06 6002 weighs 287 lbs. -- M Carden
- 24 AUG 06 6002 began training last week with general body handling and "come here" and "trunk up" commands. She is doing well with "come here" and is beginning to raise her trunk approximately $\frac{1}{2}$ - $\frac{3}{4}$ of the way up for "trunk up." - M Carden
- 26 AUG 06 6002 weighs 289 lbs. -- M Carden
- 29 AUG 06 6002 weighs 294 lbs. -- M Carden
- 05 SEP 06 6002 weighs 306 lbs. -- M Carden
- 12 SEP 06 6002 weighs 320 lbs. -- M Carden

- 19 SEP 06 Nisha, 6002, is two months old. She weighs 326 lbs. The following measurements were taken: Height at top of back – 40"; Height at withers – 38 ½"; Neck Girth – 33"; Heart Girth – 53"; Abdominal Girth – 60". She has been observed attempting to nurse from Connie, 1101, the past two days. Connie is allowing it. – J Glazier
- 20 SEP 06 Nisha, 6002, now understands these commands: "Come here," "take it," and with less compliance, "trunk up." "Hold steady" is being worked on when touching her front or back legs / feet and her back. She is variable in how much she moves around on this command. Some days she holds steady on first or second attempt; other days she may resist up to a dozen repetitions before holding steady on the first command. She has greatly improved on her general manners and rarely tries to lay down on / push / shove or kick keepers. She also doesn't try to bite as much, but she is still teething. Her lower right front tooth hasn't yet pushed through the gum and is still protruding. Nisha enjoys having her gums rubbed where she is teething. Her favorite food so far is still elephant pellets.

- 20 DEC 06 Nisha, 6002, is five months old. Her height is 47", and her weight is 496 lbs.

- 09 JAN 07 Patience, 3320, and the rest of the herd this morning had additional introductions this morning. Minyahk, 65, and Connie, 1101, were put in stalls #5 and 6 with Moola, 4022 and Nisha, 6002. Patience was put into stalls #3 and 4 to have access to Moola and Nisha through the bars for approximately 20 minutes. Minyahk, Connie, Moola and Nisha were then taken to the south yard of the breeding facility, and Patience was put in with them. The elephants were left together for 30 minutes under close supervision by keepers. Patience was then transferred back to stalls #1 and 2, Moola and Nisha in #5 and 6, and Minyahk and Connie were given corral access. Interactions with Patience and the calf were positive. No aggressive behavior was observed. – J Glazier
