- 12.Apr 3:45 Pronounced dead.
- 13.Apr 10 minute hydrotherapy on vulva and urogenital canal. Moderate amount of swelling. Some stiffness noted when elephant walks or lays down. Periodic discharge of blood in small amounts. Overall Vicky seems in good shape with normal temperment. Allowed to graze behind Bull Blg for 30 minutes. Consumed pellet ration in pm. Blood pulled for serum. (JB)
- 14.Apr Blood sample: (10:00.0) Hematology results.
WBC:18.80 *10³/UL; HCT: 5.4%;
Swelling of urogenital tract slightly increased today. She is now scratching at urogenital tract. Still some stiffness, but otherwise normal behavior and temperment. She is eating well.
- 20.Apr Pus is being expelled from urogenital tract. Initiate SID dilute Nolvasan flush for 3 to 5 days. Postpartum condition from prolonged labor. Probably localized.
Will collect CBC tomorrow. (JB)
- 21.Apr Blood sample: (9:45.0) Hematology results.
WBC:19.90 *10³/UL; HCT: 27.7%;
- 16.May Urogenital canal palpated, a few small flecks of dark blood on glove. No lesions palpable or pus seen. (JB)
- 10.Jun Removed from collection.
