Originally from Asia, Juno began her performing career in Europe with the George Mathews Circus. In 1975, she came to the United States to perform with the Blue Unit of *Ringling Bros. and Barnum & Bailey*®. After traveling for a year, Juno moved to Florida to become part of Ringling Bros. early efforts to breed Asian elephants. She is currently retired and living at the Ringling Bros. Center for Elephant Conservation (CEC) in central Florida.

Mary is expected to arrive at the El Paso Zoo from the Ringling Bros. Center for Elephant Conservation in mid-April. Upon her arrival, there will be a period of adjustment for Juno to get used to the zoo's new sights, smells and sounds before she goes on display. The timing will depend upon how well Juno becomes acclimated to her new surroundings and new caregivers. Juno also will need to adjust to the El Paso Zoo's longtime Asian elephant resident, Savannah. Depending on the two elephants, the introduction could be as short as a few days or as long as several months.

The Ringling Bros. Center for Elephant Conservation donated Juno to the El Paso Zoo to help the zoo's efforts in maintaining a social herd of Asian elephants in captivity in cooperation with the American Zoo and Aquarium Association (AZA) and Asian Elephant Species Survival Plan (SSP).

To help keep Asian elephants alive for future generations, Feld Entertainment, Inc. producers of *Ringling Bros. and Barnum & Bailey, Barnum's Kaleidoscope™, Disney On Ice™* and *Siegfried and Roy®* at the Mirage in Las Vegas, created the Ringling Bros. Center for Elephant Conservation. This 200-acre facility in central Florida is dedicated to the conservation, breeding, scientific study and retirement of the Asian elephant, enabling us to share our knowledge with the veterinary and scientific communities worldwide. 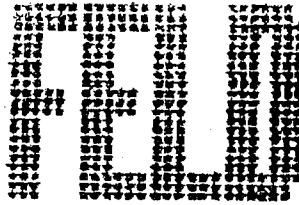
