
I have met with the Director of Parks and Recreation and the President of Friends of the Zoo regarding the purchase of 0.2 African elephants from International Animal Exchange, Inc.


I propose that the Kansas City Zoo, City of Kansas City Missouri purchase 0.2 African elephants, Loxodonta africana, from International Animal Exchange, Inc. under the following conditions and terms:

1. Purchase 0.2 African elephants, young, as identified by the photographs attached for the sum of \$35,000.00 (Thirty-five thousand dollars).
2. Purchase price includes insurance for all risks of mortality for 30 days x 24 hours beginning at time of delivery to Kansas City Zoo.
3. Purchase subject to and contingent upon re-inspection after 30 days from delivery date at which time both elephants must be acceptable physically and medically to Kansas City Zoo. One or both elephants may be returned to International Animal Exchange, Inc. as unacceptable if any deficiency is detected at the 30 day re-inspection providing the condition can be proven to be existing prior to date of arrival at Kansas City Zoo.
4. Includes delivery to Kansas City Zoo (f.o.b. Kansas City Zoo) and animals are guaranteed live arrival in good condition to be determined by Kansas City Zoo Veterinarian.

Dear Mr. Hagler:

This letter will confirm the discussions between International Animal Exchange, Inc. ("IAE") and Kansas City Zool. Park ("Purchaser") concerning your proposal to purchase from IAE 2 female African Elephants (the "Animals") on the following terms.

1. Permit.

As you know, the Animals are a "Threatened Species", subject to the requirements of the Endangered Species Act of 1973 (the "Act"). Under the Act, no protected animal may be sold or a commercial transaction entered into without the Purchaser being in possession of a valid permit. IAE understands that you are immediately making application to the Fish & Wildlife Service of the U.S. Dept. of Interior ("FWS") for a permit to enable you to purchase the Animal. You will provide IAE with a copy of the permit application. Consummation of the sale and transfer of ownership of the Animals pursuant to the sale may only be accomplished after such permit is issued.

2. Interim Use of Animal.

Solely in order to accommodate you, IAE will allow Purchaser to take possession of the Animal pending receipt of the permit. This transaction is not intended to be a commercial transaction and will merely constitute a loan of the Animals. You shall be responsible for any damage caused to or by the Animal during the loan period. During the loan period, Purchaser shall indemnify and save harmless IAE against all losses, cost or damage on account of injury to persons or property caused by the animal on loan to the Purchaser.

Purchaser warrants that it will promptly submit a permit application under the Act and that it will diligently pursue such application and will not withdraw or abandon it without the prior consent of IAE.


