See the attached diet sheet. Favorite foods include: apples, carrots, bamboo and watermelons. The AM diet is fed in a feed pan and the PM diet is eaten off of the stall floor.

Brief Reproduction Record: Relative data, introduction techniques, behavior toward young, specific concerns.

Never bred. Has never been around young elephants, only adults.

General Medical History and Physical Conditions: Usual response to medicine, including immobilizing agents and their successful mode of administration, recurring physical problems and symptoms.

Medical records have already been submitted.

Enclosure, Maintenance Data: General exhibit description, cage mates, considerations to avoid abnormal behavior, cleaning and disinfecting procedures.

The outdoor exhibit has a large pool which she spends time playing in - especially on cloudy, cool days. Tattoo shares the exhibit with a 27 yr old cow (African). They are housed separately at night. Each stall has a gate, but she has been broke to accept foot/leg chains. Tattoo is chained in the stall each morning for bathing. She is put through a routine twice a day on exhibit. Stalls are cleaned with A-125/A-33 disinfectants.

Personal Comments regarding Tattoo:

Tattoo is an extremely intelligent elephant. She can perform intricate tasks and appears to "enjoy" the challenge of learning new things. She is definitely a quick learner!

Although Tattoo is innovative, she has proven to be a very dangerous animal - especially with new, inexperienced staff. She has taken 'cheap shots' at any available opportunity. Care must be taken when new keepers are working in her vicinity. She has knocked one keeper down twice - once in the stall and once while on exhibit and has chased another keeper out of the exhibit. Both of these keepers lacked prior elephant experience.

For the most part, Tattoo is a good elephant. She cycles regularly and should be an excellent addition to your breeding herd.
