Distinguishing Physical Characteristics: Scar on right shoulder, one tusk on left side, smallest of the cows

Medical History:

- Contracted salmonella in August 1999, was restrained in ERD for 4 days and received IM injections
- Cut the left side of trunk and now has a scar
- While at Riverbanks Zoo, was in a fight with another cow and was tusked in the right shoulder and now has a scar
- Tested positive for West Nile in 2002 & 2003. Vaccinated for tetanus in 2003-04
- Vaccinated for West Nile in 2003
- Radiographs of all feet in 2004
- Eye exam 2004
- Yearly trunk washes performed to test for TB
- Weight assessment ~7,500 lbs.

Aggression History:

- Has shown aggression after chin treatments
- Has shown aggression in past restraint (pulls hands/arms) after tail/rear manipulation

Reproductive History:

- Has had trans-rectal ultrasound performed, is reproductively sound
- Has had no offspring
- Is not being bred due to age

Relationships within the Herd:

- Officially ranked 5 of 6
- Is submissive to Lady, Lea and Lois

Restraint History:

- Training to go into restraint, is hesitant since contracting salmonella

Chaining Training:

- Accepts leg chains readily
