Medical History:

- Has extra blood drawn monthly for CBC and chem panel
- Tested positive for West Nile 2003. Vaccinated for tetanus, 2003, 2004, 2005, 2006, 2007
- Vaccinated for West Nile 2003.
- Radiographs of all feet 2004, 2007, 2008
- Eye exam 2004, 2005, 2006, 2007, 2008
- Mastitis in left mammary gland in April/ May of 2005, resolved June 2005

Aggression History:

- Seldom shows aggression to keepers
- Is periodically aggressive to other cows

Reproductive History:

- Has had trans-rectal and trans-abdominal ultrasounds performed; is reproductively sound
- Became pregnant in November 1999
- carried calf to term but was unable to give birth, was given oxytocin injections but still unable to pass calf
- Trans-rectal and trans-abdominal ultrasounds repeated in June/July 2005 to reassess baby
- Went into labor 6 December 2006; passed calf
- received a Vestibulotomy and still occasionally expels discharge

- Official Ranked 2 of 7
- Was previously housed with Megan
- Is dominant to Penny, Lois, Zoë, Tattoo, and Megan
- Is submissive to Lea

Restraint Training:
