





FACILITIES, GENERAL.

§3.125 Facilities, general. (a) Structural strength. The facility must be constructed of such material and of such strength as appropriate for the animals involved. The indoor and outdoor housing facilities shall be structurally sound and shall be maintained in good repair to protect the animals from injury and to contain the animals.

The rhinoceros has started to tear the insulation off of the interior wall of his enclosure. The walls of the rhinoceros enclosure shall be repaired for the surfaces to be maintained in good repair. Correct by 1 Jan. 2008.


The swift foxes have dug in their enclosure to the point that the buried chain-link fence has become exposed. This exposed fence shall be recovered so the animals are protected from potential injury. Correct by 1 Dec. 2007.
