

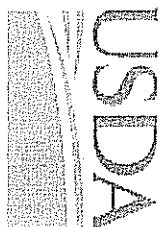

This inspection occurred over 2 days ending on August 23, 2006.

(2) Maintenance and replacement of surfaces. All surfaces must be maintained on a regular basis.

The walls in the primate enclosures in the giraffe building had the paint peeling down to the bare surface of the concrete block.

It is important to the health and well-being of the primates to have clean and well maintained primary enclosures.

The walls of the primate enclosures in the giraffe building should be painted.

FACILITIES, GENERAL.

(a) Structural strength. The facility... shall be maintained in good repair to protect the animals from injury...

The primary enclosure walls of the giraffe building needed repair, especially at the waterer mounted on the wall. The concrete was chipping away from the installation around the unit. The walls in the hall of the building had a large crack, 3 centimeters, between the floor and the wall. Many of the walls in this building had peeling paint.

It is important to the health and well-being of the animals to live in well maintained building.

The walls in the giraffe building need to be painted, cracks sealed with silicone or other appropriate building material and the wall with the waterer repaired to prevent concrete from falling in the giraffe water bowl.

Correct by December 31, 2006.

This inspection occurred with the staff veterinarian and the zoo keeper of each area. The exit interview occurred with the staff veterinarian and the facilities administrator.

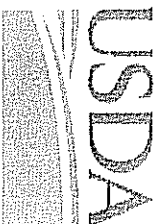

ENVIRONMENT ENHANCEMENT TO PROMOTE PSYCHOLOGICAL WELL-BEING.

Dealers, exhibitors, and research facilities must develop, document, and follow an appropriate plan for environment enhancement adequate to promote the psychological well-being of nonhuman primates. The plan must be in accordance with the currently accepted professional standards as cited in appropriate professional journals or reference guides, and as directed by the attending veterinarian. This plan must be made available to APHIS upon request, and, in the case of research facilities, to officials of any pertinent funding agency. The plan, at a minimum, must address each of the following:

One cotton topped tamarin housed in the Monkey Island exhibit is being housed alone. Documentation of enrichment was not available. Documentation must occur to insure this animal is being provided enrichment as a singly housed primate. [The second cotton topped tamarin that was historically housed with this animal died, and the replacement tamarin is still in quarantine.]

3.125 (a)
FACILITIES, GENERAL.

(a) Structural strength. The facility must be constructed of such material and of such strength as appropriate for the animals involved. The indoor and outdoor housing facilities shall be structurally sound and shall be maintained in good repair to protect the animals from injury and to contain the animals.
(b) Water and power. Reliable and adequate electric power, if required to comply with other provisions of this subpart, and adequate potable water

Metal plaques on den box walls of lion holding area are composed of galvanized metal, and the paint is peeling from these surfaces. These surfaces need to be kept in good repair, so paint chips do not fall into the water or feed containers, or are ingested by the lions.
