This agreement will remain in effect until terminated or as stipulated herein.

A. Type of Loan: Exhibit

B. Obligations of the Loaning Party(s):

1. It is agreed that in the event of disease, injury, or death of the specimen that the receiving party will be held harmless and free of responsibility to the loaning party and that no claim will be made by the latter against the former.
2. All information available regarding the past history of the specimen including but not limited to diet, breeding record, medical history, genetics, etc., will be disclosed to the recipient.
3. In the event the loaning party decides to sell, trade, or otherwise dispose of the specimen, the receiving party shall have first right of refusal to acquire said specimen.

C. Obligations of Receiving Party:

1. Prior to the return of the specimen, the loaning party shall be given 30 days written notice of the receiving party's intentions to cancel this agreement and return the specimen. At the time of shipping, advance notice will be given of estimated arrival time, the carrier and any other information necessary to properly prepare for the transfer.
2. In the event of any viable young being born or hatched, either during the term of this agreement or within a period measured by the normal gestation or incubation of the particular species after termination of this agreement, the young will be divided as follows: _____

3. The loaning party will be notified within 24 hours of any births or hatching of offspring resulting from this agreement, serious illness, escapes (even if recaptured) and mortality.
 4. In the event it becomes necessary to subject the specimen to any high risk procedure for veterinary care or husbandry, immobilization, or relocation, permission must be obtained to proceed from the Director or appropriate curator of the loaning party in advance. This requirement is waived in the of an emergency but notification must be given as soon as possible following the procedure.
 5. The specimens described herein shall not be transferred to another location or party beyond the contiguous boundaries of the receiving party without permission of the loaning party(s).
 6. No invasive or stressful research shall be permitted.
 7. An annual status report will be sent to the loaning party each year by January 30th.
 8. The loaning party shall be identified in any articles published, or announcement made, regarding the specimens covered by this agreement.
 9. Upon termination of this agreement, all health and husbandry information, breeding records and mortality data on the offspring and or specimens on loan, accumulated during the term of the agreement will be forwarded to the loaning party.
 10. The receiving party will provide accurate information as requested for any regional studbook maintained under the authority of the AZA and acknowledge the loaning party as the owner for said studbook data. International studbooks will be responded to by the loaning party.
- D. All shipping costs, crating costs and attendant charges are the responsibility of the consignee as identified in the transfer documents.

F. Mortality:

The limitations of the responsibility of the receiving party in the event of the death of the specimens covered by the agreement and their offspring are as follows:

1. A complete necropsy exam shall be performed by a veterinarian to determine cause of death. This shall include any laboratory or histopathologically exam needed. A complete and detailed report of the findings, and diagnosis shall be sent to the loaning party. The necropsy exam shall be performed in such a manner as to preserve the specimen for further scientific study or taxidermy.
2. The carcass and its parts shall remain the property of the loaning party and it will be its sole responsibility to determine the disposition of the above.

G. Either party may terminate the agreement prior the the term identified by giving the other 30 days prior notice. In the event the welfare of the specimen may be considered to be in jeopardy for any reason the loaning party may cancel the agreement immediately and recover the specimen by any means that best serves the continued welfare of the specimen and that does not violate any Federal, State or local laws or ordinance.

H. Any amendments or changes to this agreement must be made in writing and approved by all parties.

I. The receiving party hereby agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the Montgomery Zoo, its trustees, officers, and employees against any and all claims, occasioned by the receiving institutions negligence, including claims for personal injury, wrongful death, property damage, damage to animals or other losses, costs or expenses arising out of or in connection with this Loan Agreement of the loan of the specimen identified herein.

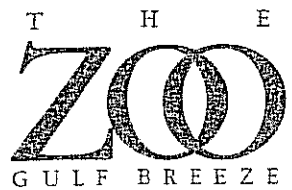

Pre-purchase health requirements

- I. Salmonella negative fecal cultures, a total of three cultures are required they should be collected at one week intervals.
- II. Fecal direct examination and fecal flotation-one of each test.
- III. Yearly tuberculosis culture results (3) from National Veterinary Services Laboratory.
- IV. In all cases of disease or death the Montgomery Zoo veterinary staff should be contacted or Advised of all conditions, testing, treatments, and results.
- V. No sedation or anesthetic procedures shall take place for any reason without permission and consultation of the management of the Montgomery Zoo. This shall not be interpreted to limit emergency procedures as needed when significant health issues arise.
- VI. All testing is to be done by a licensed veterinarian.
- VII. CBC, Chemistry Panel, Vitamin E and selenium levels.
- VIII. Forward copies of previous medical records and treatment for review.

Terms of Purchase

The City of Montgomery Zoo agrees to purchase two adult female African elephants which are between seventeen and nineteen years of age approximately, for total price of \$200,000 dependent upon the following terms:

- A) Seller is to receive a check in the amount of \$200,000 by November 14th 2003
- B) Seller can provide proof of ownership, legal acquisition and permit compliance
- C) seller agrees to transport the elephants to Montgomery Zoo and accompany the animals initially to the Montgomery Zoo for a period of ten to fourteen days; the purchaser will provide lodging and pay expenses for this stay. In lieu of this option purchaser may elect the animals to be transported to a designated holding facility within a maximum distance of 450 miles from Montgomery, Alabama. This option would be the sole decision of the Montgomery Zoo; however, the seller will only be required to transport the elephant to a maximum of one Destination. This destination will be selected on or before the last day of January 2004. Beyond this date the elephants will be delivered on a date agreed upon by buyer and seller.

- D) The City of Montgomery Zoo being able to secure any required legal permits.
- E) The elephant will be housed on the seller's property for the exclusive contingent of the city of Montgomery Zoo until their elephant holding facility is completed.
- F) All medical results must be forwarded to the Montgomery Zoo to the attention of Dr. Don Gillespie before payment is made.
- G) All medical testing must be completed and status of the elephants evaluated and Approved by Dr. Don Gillespie DVM, before seller receives payment.
- H) Any damages to persons or properties by the elephants while in the possession of the seller are the sole responsibility of the seller.
- I) Payment in full will be made when the purchaser secures mortality insurance on the elephants. Seller will keep liability insurance on the elephants.
- J) No promises or guarantees after sale is finale .
- K) purchaser has to sign and return contract within 10 days of the date listed below, or contract is void

- C) The City of Montgomery Zoo being able to secure any required legal permits
- D) The elephant will be housed on the seller's property at 2235 Hampton Road, Wellford, South Carolina for the exclusive contingent of the City of Montgomery Zoo until their option is exercised. If that option extends beyond

Concerning the following specimen(s):

1.0 Bull African Elephant

This agreement will remain in effect until terminated or as stipulated herein.

A. Type of Loan: **BREEDING**

B. Obligations of the Loaning Party(s):

1. It is agreed that in the event of disease, injury, or death of the specimen that the receiving party will be held harmless and free of responsibility to the loaning party and that in the absence of negligence no claim will be made by the latter against the former.
2. All information available regarding the past history of the specimen including but not limited to diet, breeding record, medical history, genetics, etc., will be disclosed to the recipient.
3. In the event the loaning party decides to sell, trade or otherwise dispose of the specimen, the receiving party shall have first right of refusal to acquire said specimen.

C. Obligations of Receiving Party:

1. In the event of any viable young (viable being defined as having lived thirty (30) days) being born or hatched either during the term of this agreement or within a period measured by the normal gestation or incubation of the particular species after termination of this agreement, the young will be divided as follows: **RECEIPIENT OWNS ODD NUMBERED OFFSPRING, SENDER OWNS EVEN NUMBERED OFFSPRING** (Montgomery-1st, 3rd & 5th, Lowry Park 2nd, 4th & 6th)
2. The loaning party will be notified within 24 hours of any births or hatching of offspring resulting from this agreement, serious illness, escapes (even if recaptured) and mortality.
3. In the event it becomes necessary to subject the specimen to any high risk procedure for veterinary care or husbandry, immobilization, or relocation, permission must be obtained to proceed from the Director or appropriate curator of the loaning party in advance. This requirement is waived in the event of an emergency but notification must be given as soon as possible following the procedure.

4. The specimens described herein shall not be transferred to another location or party beyond the contiguous boundaries of the receiving party without permission of the loaning party(s).
5. No invasive or stressful research shall be permitted.
6. An annual status report will be sent to the loaning party each year by January 30th.
7. The loaning party shall be identified in any articles published, or announcements made, regarding the specimen(s) covered by this agreement.
8. Upon termination of this agreement all health and husbandry information, breeding records and mortality data on the offspring and/or specimens on loan accumulated during the term of the agreement will be forwarded to the loaning party.
9. The receiving party will provide accurate information as requested for any regional studbook maintained under the authority of the AZA and acknowledge the loaning party as the owner for said studbook data. International studbooks will be responded to by the loaning party.

D. Mortality:

The limitations of the responsibility of the receiving party in the event of the death of the specimens covered by the agreement and their offspring are as follows:

1. A complete necropsy exam shall be performed by a veterinarian to determine cause of death. This shall include any laboratory or histopathology exam needed. A complete and detailed report of the findings and diagnosis shall be sent to the loaning party. The necropsy exam shall be performed in such a manner as to preserve the specimen for further scientific study or taxidermy.
2. The carcass and its parts shall remain the property of the loaning party and it will be its sole responsibility to determine the disposition of the above.

E. Termination

Either party may terminate the agreement prior to the term identified by giving the other 30 days prior notice. In the event the welfare of the specimen may be considered to be in jeopardy for any reason the loaning party may cancel the agreement immediately and recover the specimen by any means that best serves the continued welfare of the specimen and that does not violate any Federal, State or local laws or ordinances.

F. Amendments

Any amendments or changes to this agreement must be made in writing and approved by all parties.

- G. This loan agreement will be in effect for two-years from the date of this signed agreement.
