- Animals will not be sold or traded to any facility for the purpose of providing game for recreation or subsistence hunting, for use in any stressful or terminal research programs, or for eventual disposal at any animal auction.
- Animals will be housed, fed and maintained in a manner that will insure their health and well-being.
- The offer for sale or trade of endangered species is contingent upon the receipt of appropriate permits issued by the United States Fish and Wildlife Service.
- The buyer is responsible for all necessary permits required to procure these animals.
- With regard to purchases, crates will be provided by shipper, unless otherwise stated. Animals must be in satisfactory and acceptable condition upon arrival at the Oklahoma City Zoo. Health certificates signed by a licensed Veterinarian verifying the absence of specific diseases accompanied by certificates of origin are required. The Oklahoma City Zoo agrees to promptly meet all incoming shipments, to transport them properly and to give them the best possible care while at the zoo.
- With regard to sales, cost of specimens does not include freight or crates, unless otherwise stated. Crates, if available, will be provided but must be returned prepaid within thirty (30) days, unless otherwise stated. A crate deposit may be required. Unless otherwise stated, specimens become the property of the purchaser when crated and accepted by owner or owner's authorized agent. Health certificates, medical and husbandry records as well as ARKS reports will be provided.
