As per the above reference; the enclosed application requires the following attachments:

1. Specie to be imported: African Elephant - Loxodonta africana
Number to be imported - two (2) Females.
Age - young
Activity - importation to U.S. and transport to Rochester, New York.
2. These elephants at time of this application have already been removed from the wild and are at a quarantine station in Africa.
3. These animals are orphaned individuals that were taken from the wild. If it were not for their capture; they would have died or would have been killed.
4. These animals were taken from the wild in the country of South Africa.
5. The Seneca Park Zoo is owned by the City of Rochester and operated by the County of Monroe, Rochester, New York through the Parks Dept. It is a municipal zoo which is open to the public 365 days a year.
6. i. Sketch of enclosure on separate sheet. Note: a new enclosure is planned to be completed by 1981 and has been designed by Jerry Johnson Associates (a professional zoo design firm).
- ii. The Zoo Director has 16 yrs. of experience in the management of wild animals. The Assistant Zoo Director has 12 years of experience in the management of wild animals. This is complimented by two Foreman and a staff of 12 trained Zoo Attendants. A team of 5 veterinarians are under contract to supply the best medical care.

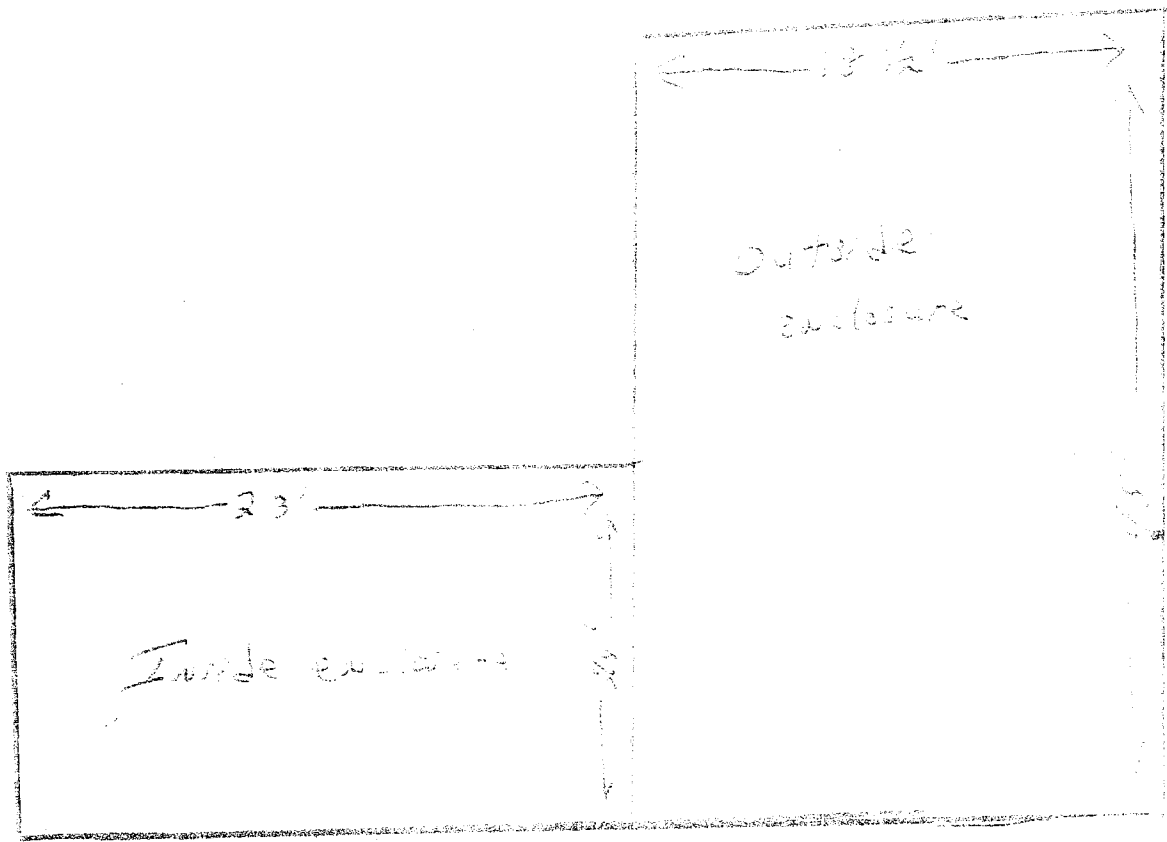

6. iii. The Seneca Park Zoo is willing to participate and cooperate with breeding programs and will contribute data to any studbook.

iv. Crates will be made of wood construction, custom built for the animals with capabilities to feed, water and clean during transit.

v. In Oct. of 1978 a female Asiatic Elephant was euthanized by the veterinarian due to a severe case of arthritis. The cause for this condition was not known. Many months of intensive veterinary care preceded the decision to euthanize.

7. Enclosed are copies of: County of Monroe, Seneca Park Zoo - "Animal Transaction Confirmation" Form signed Nov. 25, 1978 by Director Daniel R. Michalowski and on Nov. 29, 1978 by Mr. Thomas Hunt of International Animal Exchange, Inc. Also enclosed is a copy of a letter from Daniel R. Michalowski dated August 11, 1978 to Mr. Thomas Hunt extending the delivery date of the transaction confirmation.

8. i. To be permitted to move in a Commercial activity interstate 2 female African Elephants purchased from International Animal Exchange, Inc.

ii. The elephants will be transported from Africa by freighter-ship to U.S. port of entry. From this point they will be moved by truck to Rochester.

iii. Secure a male for breeding loan or artificial insemination, when they reach breeding age.

iv. The elephants will remain at Seneca Park Zoo for the purpose of public exhibition and education.
